Chinese Wine

Kweichow Maotai (53%) - £368

Kweichow Maotai is the most revered of Chinese liquors. It is made from high quality broomcorn and wheat and its primarily consumed as a celebratory drink, its aroma and taste reminiscent of Soy Sauce, Pear, Walnut and Almond which characteristics elegance, purity and long lasting after taste. Maotai has been used on official occasion in feasts with foreign heads of state and distinguished guests visiting China. It is the only alcoholic beverage presented as an official gift by Chinese embassies in foreign countries and regions.

Er Guo Tou (56%) - £43

This tradition red star and a typical Chinese liquor which is called the Chinese vodka is made from Sorghum and fresh rose flower. Er Guo Tou has been the most popular drink in the Northern China. Its sweet lingering taste of this fire cracker deceives you at 56 % ABV which is packed with a punch
